A RESOLUTION

Further amending Constitutional Emergency Order No. 20-03 by extending the expiration date thereof to February 6, 2021.

- 1 WHEREAS, by the authority vested in the Governor pursuant to
- 2 Article 13, Section 9 of the Pohnpei Constitution, the Honorable Reed B.
- 3 Oliver has declared a State of Emergency for Pohnpei State due to the
- 4 undeniable imminent threat of COVID-19, and has continuously remained in
- 5 a State of Emergency; and
- 6 WHEREAS, in the wake of the global pandemic of COVID-19,
- 7 commencing on March 11, 2020, the Governor of Pohnpei State has issued
- 8 three consecutive Constitutional Emergency Orders concerning COVID-19;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, the first Constitutional Emergency Order No. 20-01 was
- issued on March 11, 2020, which sets the State's level of preparedness of
- response to COVID-19 and later on March 21, 2020 the Governor ordered a
- 13 statewide lockdown, banning all incoming passengers into the state of
- 14 Pohnpei; and
- 15 WHEREAS, on April 09, 2020, the Tenth Pohnpei Legislature
- exercised its power pursuant to the provisions of Article 13, Section 9(3),
- and adopted L.R. No. 25-20 extending the effects of Constitutional
- 18 Emergency Order No. 20-01 to May 10, 2020; and
- 19 WHEREAS, the second Constitutional Emergency Order No. 20-02
- was issued on May 11, 2020 and was set to expire on June 10, 2020 and on
- June 09, a day prior to the expiration of the Order, the Tenth Pohnpei
- 22 Legislature once again exercised its authority and adopted L.R. No. 34-20,
- 23 L.D.1 further extending the effects of Constitutional Emergency Order No.
- 24 20-02 to July 10, 2020; and
- 25 WHEREAS, the third, Constitutional Emergency Order No. 20-03, was

1	issued on July 11, 2020 and was set to expire on August 10, 2020; and in the
2	assessment of its sworn duties, the Tenth Pohnpei Legislature on July 24,
3	2020 adopted L.R. No. 30-20 substantially amending the Constitutional
4	Emergency Order No. 20-03 with respect to restrictions to international and
5	interstate travel; and
6	WHEREAS, on August 07, 2020, the Pohnpei Legislature adopted
7	L.R. No. 40-20 amending the language of the Constitutional Emergency
8	Order No. 20-03 and further extending the effects of the Constitutional
9	Emergency Order No. 20-03 for 120 days counting from July 11, 2020,
10	which was set to expire on November 08, 2020; and
Ų1	WHEREAS, the Tenth Pohnpei Legislature cannot overlook the
12	undeniable fact that COVID-19, continues to remain as a worldwide threat
13	with no discovered vaccine to combat the disease, and also recognizes that
14	there is a limited resource available here in the state of Pohnpei and
15	therefore the Tenth Pohnpei Legislature finds it a paramount need to
16	safeguard the lives of the people, our economy and our state; now, therefore,
17	BE IT RESOLVED by the Tenth Pohnpei Legislature, Third Regular
18	Session, 2020, that in accordance with the authority vested in the Pohnpei
19	Legislature pursuant to Section 9(3) of Article 13 of the Pohnpei Constitution,
20	that the NOW THEREFORE, clause under Paragraph 8 of Constitutional
21	Emergency Order No. 20-03 is hereby further amended to read as follows:
22	"8) Unless revoked or amended sooner, this Constitutional
23	Emergency Order is valid for a period of two hundred and ten (210)
24	days counting from July 11, 2020"; and
25	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this

1	resolution be transmitted to the Governor of Pohnpei, to the Chief Justice of
.2	the Pohnpei Supreme Court, to the President of the Federated States of
3	Micronesia, to the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
4	Micronesia, and to the Chief Justice of the FSM Supreme Court.
